CHARLES SYKES'  
RECORD WIN 1993

<b>8 years ago</b>	<b>in 2010</b>	Jim Fisher became Master i/c The Wilson Run. This is his last one before he retires.
<b>25 years ago</b>	<b>In 1993</b>	Charles Sykes broke Pumphrey's record which had held for 94 years.
<b>50 years ago</b>	<b>In 1968</b>	The Race was run in the worst conditions imaginable. A very wet course, strong wind & snow.
<b>70 years ago</b>	<b>In 1948</b>	A temperature of 79°F and a large number of female spectators in summer dresses presented a sight more typical of Ascot on Gold Cup Day than Sedbergh on Wilson Run Day.
<b>100 years ago</b>	<b>In 1918</b>	Won by Duxbury who had transferred from School House to the newly opened Winder House. However, his name was still recorded on the SH Honours boards.
<b>120 years ago</b>	<b>In 1898</b>	From a field of 16 runners, Will Grandage set a record time of 1:12:13 to be beaten by Pumphrey in 1899.
