| 5 years ago | In 2011: | Melanie Hyder set the current girls' record time. |
| 10 years ago | In 2006: | Simon Barnby's (SH) first of two wins. The training course was established this season. |
| 15 years ago | In 2001: | Cancelled for only the third time ever because of the Foot and Mouth outbreak. |
| 25 years ago | In 1991: | Won by Andy Brown (P) who went on to host School Expedition to Everest in 2003 and who trekked to the South Pole in 2006. |
| 70 years ago | In 1946: | First Race run after WWII with a record field of 79 runners. This year 174 runners qualified. |
| 100 years ago | In 1916: | Won by FV Kidson (SH) wearing a white silk shirt, thought to be 'not quite the done thing'. His father remarked that 'you will never feel such a swell again'. |

In today's race (G) indicates Gold standard (1 hr 20 / 1 hr 45) & (S) indicates Silver standard (1 hr 35/ 2 hrs)
