RIDERS' KIT LIST 2021 - 2022

All pupils and staff must wear the correct personal protective clothing when riding or handling the ponies. Several of these items are available to borrow from the stables, if required.

If in doubt as to suitability of any item, please ask advice from the riding staff.

Personal protective clothing required for riding

- Riding hat (compulsory) and must meet the current health and safety standards. Riding hats must have been correctly fitted by a reputable saddler. Please be aware that some retailers' hats do not comply with current safety standards.
 1. British - PAS 015: 1998 or 2011 provided they are BSI Kite marked
 2. VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kite marked
 3. European - VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kite marked
 4. American - ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked SNELL E2001
 5. Australian and New Zealand - AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked
- Jodhpurs
- Riding boots, short jodhpur – recommended, or long rubber, with a fairly smooth sole and well-defined heel
- Gloves
- Long sleeved top (no hoodies)
- Suitable coat for inclement weather (without a hood)
- No jewellery
- Hair must be tied up securely
- Body Protector is recommended but not compulsory

Personal protective clothing required for pony care activities when on the yard and handling the ponies

- Riding hat – see above
- Jodhpurs or similar
- Substantial footwear such as riding boots or wellingtons. Boots with a steel toe cap are recommended to prevent toe crushing injury.
- Gloves
- Long sleeved top (no hoodies)
- Suitable coat for inclement weather (without a hood)
- No jewellery
- Hair must be tied up securely
- Dust masks are available for allergy sufferers
