School riding staff are British Horse Society accredited coaches and have a wealth of experience, teaching children of all ages to ride and care for ponies.

Casterton Sedbergh Prep Riding is an active Pony Club Centre and pupils are encouraged to set personal riding goals and work towards achieving badges and awards.

Fees for optional riding lessons from September 2021 are £31.50 per lesson.

Please note the minimum age for a rider is 5 years old.

Pupils will undertake one lesson per week. Charges are payable in arrears on pupil accounts and are based on a 30-minute lesson.

Pupils enrolled in riding are required to be Pony Club Branch Members to benefit from the full range of activities available (see Pony Club Membership Letter published on the Prep School website). Pupils enrolled in riding lessons are welcome to join pony club activities on Saturday mornings free of charge.
