For overseas pupils requiring a visa, to include Confirmation And Acceptance of Studies (CAS)

NOTES:

- a) The Standard Terms and Conditions of Sedbergh School, in particular clause 4.6, refer to the exclusion of a pupil at any time where fees are unpaid. Such exclusion may be intimated to apply at either half term or the end of the term in which the fees are unpaid. A pupil will be deemed withdrawn without notice 28 days after exclusion.
- b) School Fees are annual but split into three terms with all other charges payable in full on or before the first day of each term by Direct Debit. School fees can also be paid monthly by Direct Debit by taking the value of the terms invoice and dividing by the four months in a term to arrive at the monthly amount due. A late payment surcharge will automatically be made on overdue accounts in accordance with our Standard Terms and Conditions unless other special written agreements have been made.
- c) Notice must be given *before* the beginning of each term or half term if music lessons are no longer required. Lessons will be charged until the proper notice has been given whether the pupil attends the lessons or not.
- d) Termly Fees cover board, residence, tuition, laundry charges, and most textbooks.
- e) All Termly Fees and other charges are subject to termly reviews in accordance with our Standard Terms and Conditions.
- f) Any remaining Acceptance Deposit will be credited to a pupil's final account on leaving in accordance with the Standard Terms and Conditions.
- g) Fees in lieu of notice are payable at the start of the term to which they relate.
- h) Please refer to clause 3.3 and 3.4 of the School's Terms and Conditions regarding deposits.
